The County AGM this year will be on Easter Monday, 28th March and will be based at Tunstall. The day will comprise a service, lunch and the Annual General Meeting itself. A variety of towers within the Rochester and Canterbury Districts will be open on three routes leading towards Tunstall in the morning and back to neighbouring Districts in the evening.

### **Service**

The service will take place at St John the Baptist, Tunstall ME9 8DU starting at 12 noon, and will be preceded by ringing by an invited band from 11.45am. There will however be open ringing from 11 – 11.45am.

### **Lunch**

Lunch will be at Tunstall Village Hall, Tunstall Road, Sittingbourne ME10 1YZ commencing at 1pm, and the cost will be £15 per head for a filling chef-prepared 2-course meal followed by tea and coffee. The menu for lunch is as follows:
