The County AGM this year will be on Easter Monday, 17th April and will be based at Cranbrook. The day will comprise a service, lunch and the Annual General Meeting itself. A variety of towers within the Ashford, Maidstone and Tonbridge Districts will be open on 3 routes leading towards Cranbrook in the morning and back to neighbouring Districts in the evening.

Service

The service will take place at St Dunstan's, Cranbrook TN17 3EX starting at 12 noon, and will be preceded by ringing by an invited band from 11.45am. There will however be open ringing from 11 – 11.45am.

Lunch

Lunch will be at Vestry Hall, TN17 3HA (next to the church) at 1pm, and the cost will be £15 per head for a filling chef-prepared 2-course meal followed by tea and coffee. The menu for lunch is:

Annual General Meeting

All KCACR members are welcome to attend the AGM at 2.30pm at Vestry Hall, Cranbrook (next to the church). Cranbrook bells will be available after the meeting and other towers will be open on three routes leading out of the District.

Parking

Parking is available in Jockey Lane (next to the church) with two disabled parking spaces; Tanyard car park (off The Hill and 3 minutes walk to the church and Vestry Hall); the Co-op car park (off the High Street and 4 minutes walk to the church and Vestry Hall); and street parking but here some restrictions may apply. (Note that there is no parking allowed in Stone Street and High Street parking is limited to 1 hour only). All parking is free.
