Apologies for absence

34 members signed the attendance book.

2015/QMA01 Minutes and any matters arising from previous meeting:

2014/ADM 11th October 2014. The minutes were agreed and signed. There were no matters arising.

2015/QMA02 Election of new members:

Ashleigh Horton, junior member from Marden, was proposed by James Davis and seconded by James Sawle. Selina Carter of Boughton Monchelsea was proposed by Anthony Adams and seconded by Margaret Fitzgerald. Michelle Clement and Peter John Titley, both from Wrotham, were proposed by Elizabeth Barnes and seconded by Phillip Barnes. All were duly elected, and welcomed to the Association.

Similarly the 120 Club Admin and Licence fees of £52 were comprised of £20 for the licence fee and postage costs. The Treasurer was asked whether the accounts had been audited.
