The County AGM this year will be on Easter Monday, 2nd April and will be based at Willesborough. The day will comprise a service, lunch and the Annual General Meeting itself. A variety of towers within the Ashford District will be open on 2 routes leading towards Willesborough in the morning and back to neighbouring Districts in the evening.

Service

The service will take place at St Mary the Virgin, Willesborough TN24 0HZ starting at 12 noon, and will be preceded by ringing by an invited band from 11.45am. There will however be open ringing from 11 – 11.45am.
