The County AGM this year will be on Easter Monday, 22<sup>nd</sup> April and will be based at Chilham. The day will comprise a service, lunch and the Annual General Meeting itself. A variety of towers within the Canterbury District will be open on 2 routes leading towards Chilham in the morning and one route away to neighbouring Districts in the evening.

### **Service**

The service will take place at St Mary, Chilham CT4 8DA starting at 12 noon, and will be preceded by ringing by an invited band from 11.45am. There will however be open ringing from 11.00 - 11.45am.

### **Lunch**

Lunch will be in the village hall at 1pm, and the cost will be £15 per head (£7.50 for children) for a chef-prepared 2- course meal followed by tea and coffee. The menu for lunch is:
