

KCACR Tonbridge District 120 Club Rules and Conditions (October 2020)

- 1 Anyone aged 16 years or over may apply for membership of the KCACR Tonbridge District 120 Club (subsequently referred to as 'The Club').
- 2 Each member is required to pay the annual sum of £10 in advance for a share which will entitle him/her to participate in each of the monthly draws. Members may purchase one or more shares and will be allocated a number(s) for the year.
- 3 All numbers are entered into each draw. The first draw will take place in October of each year. Subsequent draws will take place on successive months up to and including the following July. Each draw will take place at a Tonbridge District event. Prize winners will be notified by email and a list of winning numbers will be published on the KCACR website and quarterly in 'Look To' or may be obtained on request from the Honorary Promoter.
- 4 If less than 120 shares are sold The Club will take up all unsold shares so that a minimum of 120 shares are entered into each draw.
- 5 The prizes for the two months of October and January will be
1st £40 2nd £30 3rd £20
The prizes for the eight months November, December and February to July will be
1st £20 2nd £15 3rd £10
At the first draw of the series held at each ADM in October 45% of any fund over £1,200 will be awarded as a bonus prize, and the first three numbers drawn at the ADM will be re-entered into the bonus draw.
- 6 The cost of a 2nd class stamp will be deducted from prize money that cannot be paid by electronic transfer.
- 7 The profit remaining after deduction of prize money and expenses will be donated to the Kent County Association of Change Ringers Bell Restoration Fund, Training Fund and Kent Young Ringers Fund. At the end of each season, shareholders will be able to indicate a preference for their contribution to be allocated to one or more funds. Each share will count as one vote so that those with more than one share will have a corresponding number of votes. If shareholders choose not to vote their contribution will be split evenly across the three funds. Profits will then be allocated to each KCACR fund in proportion to the number of votes received.
- 8 The Club will be administered and controlled by the Kent County Association of Change Ringers, Tonbridge District 120 Club Sub-committee and the decisions of this sub-committee shall be final and binding in any matter requiring adjudication. The sub-committee shall also have the power to amend or revoke these rules at their discretion, insofar as is consistent with current legislation.
- 9 The Club shall be conducted as a Small Society Lottery in accordance with Schedule 11 Parts 4 & 5 of the Gambling Act 2005.
- 10 Personal data is held solely for The Club's administrative purposes and is not shared with any other organisations or individuals. In purchasing a share, members agree to their personal data being held by The Club. Members should contact the Club Treasurer to be reminded of personal data held by The Club and can request any/all data to be deleted. It should be noted that it may become difficult or impossible to contact members or pay prize money if personal data is deleted from The Club's database.
