The Kent County Association of Change Ringers Annual General Meeting

The County AGM this year will be on Easter Monday, 21st April at Sevenoaks. The day will comprise a service, and the Annual General Meeting itself. Towers in the Tonbridge District will be open on 2 routes leading towards Sevenoaks in the morning and back to neighbouring Districts in the evening.

Service

The service will take place at St Nicholas, Sevenoaks TN13 1JA starting at 12 noon, and will be preceded by ringing by an invited band from 11.45am. There will be open ringing from 11 – 11.45am.

Lunch

The period for lunch is from 12.30 to 14.00. Please bring your own lunch. There are shops nearby in the town which sell food (Waitrose, Bagel shop, pubs, cafes/restaurants) but not all will be open Easter Monday.

There will be filter coffee, tea, herbal teas, milk, alternative milks, sugar, squash and water, and biscuits/cake available in the St Nicholas church undercroft. The undercroft may also be used for eating lunch should members wish.

Toilets are provided in the undercroft.

Annual General Meeting

All KCACR members are welcome to attend the AGM at 2pm in the undercroft of St Nicholas church. The AGM will be followed by the Extraordinary General Meeting

Sevenoaks bells will be available after the meeting and other towers will be open on two routes leading out of the District as set out below.

Car Parking

Brasted – Car park by church (Free)

Hadlow – Street parking

Horsmonden – park on the “Green” on approach to the church (Free)

Kemsing – church car park or public car park at the adjacent entrance (Both free)

Otford – Car park behind the church. Access is from the Duck Pond roundabout. (Free)

Tonbridge – Church car park off Church Street (Free), Kinnings Row car park off Bordenyke (Charge),

Tunbridge Wells – Street parking (beware Permit Holders’ bays), Crescent Road car park (Charge) and 10-minute walk.

Westerham – Street parking by The Green (Free), Quebec Avenue car park off London Road (Charge)
