

KCACR Youth Officer Role

The KCACR Youth Officer is elected annually at the AGM and holds a voting role on the KCACR General Committee.

Purpose of the role

The Youth Officer's role exists to foster and encourage ringing amongst the junior members of the Association in an enjoyable and safe atmosphere, and to promote an awareness of youth ringing throughout the Association. The role aims to give opportunities to young ringers both to consolidate and to extend their ringing abilities and to enable the development of leadership skills.

Pre-requisites

- An enhanced DBS check is required for this role.
- Experience of ringing with children and / or an awareness of the issues they encounter when ringing is desirable.
- Advanced ringing skills and / or long ringing experience are beneficial, but not essential.

Duties

1. Completing relevant safeguarding training appropriate to the role.
2. To coordinate and encourage an annual programme of ringing activities and outings for Kent Young Ringers and Kent MINI-Ringers as appropriate
3. To be responsible for entering a team into the annual Ringing World National Youth Contest and other events
4. To arrange an annual Youth Inter-District Striking Contest
5. To report to the Association and liaise with the Chairman and other officers as appropriate
6. To liaise with the District Youth Representatives
7. To maintain, update and oversee information and reports on the KCACR website and Facebook pages
8. To draw up and update any required Risk Assessment documents for ringing and outings
